Short Synopsis: A pair of down on their luck detectives, Tracy and Dick, are waiting in their office for a case. Scarlett, a femme fatale, walks in and asks the detectives to help her. She is being blackmailed by the notorious Purring Killers Gang. Tracy and Dick take the case and must find the gang before it's too late.

Long Synopsis: *Surprise P.I.* is a short parody noir inspired by a cartoon short. The idea for the story came to the writer when she was watching a short by Rooster Teeth in which some of their animated characters were in a noir film. She wanted to use the quirky comedy style of films from the 80's like *Airplane!* or *Loaded Weapon*. The story begins with Tracy lamenting through voice over how things have changed from the old days of crime solving. The business hasn't been going well and on top of that, it's Tracy's birthday. Dick tells him not to worry so much and things will look up.

Scarlett walks into the office and asks the detectives for help. She is being blackmailed by the notorious Purring Killers Gang. They have some photos of her that they going to release if she doesn't pay them. The detectives take the case and head over to Falstachio's to get more information. Alfonso, the owner, tells them that the Purring Killers own a warehouse up the street and gives them the code to the back door.

Dick and Tracy attempt to break into the warehouse. Dick sneezes and runs away. Tracy gets kidnapped by one of the members of the Purring Killers. When Tracy wakes up, he is tied to a chair in a warehouse. Scarlett comes out of the darkness and reveals that she is the leader of the Purring Killers Gang. It was all a rouse to capture Tracy. Dick emerges from the shadows and pulls a gun on Tracy.

Dick reveals that he was working with Scarlett the whole time. Tracy closes his eyes as Dick fires the gun. BANG! A flag rolls out of the gun and the lights turn on as everyone yells "Surprise!" Alfonso pops out from behind the bar and brings a cake over. Dick and Scarlett reveal that this was all a rouse to throw Tracy a surprise party for his birthday. The film ends with Tracy taking a bite of cake and winking at the camera.



Annant Gaur 1st Assistant Director



Siobhan Nowak is a filmmaker who specializes in Production Design.


